

Appearance Standards

All volunteers must come with the correct Appearance Standards. If you arrive and are not in compliance you will be unable to volunteer, which will have an effect on ticket remuneration.

Hair:

- Must be clean, combed and natural in color
- Above the eyebrows, and length must be even
- Limit the use of barrettes and ribbons
- Men's hair must be above the collar
- Shaved designs, spikes, dreadlocks, ponytails and mohawks are not permitted
- Longer hair may need to be restrained

Facial Hair:

- Only facial hair allowed is an existing moustache
- Can not extend beyond the corner of your mouth
- Sideburns must be neatly trimmed and not below the earlobe

Sunglasses:

- Simple in style
- Not mirrored

Hats:

- Solid color ball cap
- No logo
- No other covering allowed

Jewelry:

- Keep to a minimum
- You may only wear paired earrings
- Can not dangle
- No larger than a dime
- All other piercing is not allowed (i.e. nose, lip, tongue, etc.)

Pants:

- Any pants, capris and shorts are allowed
- Solid khaki, black, or navy in color (No denim please)
- Seven-inch inseam

Shirts:

- Any plain (no logo) white polo-type shirt
- No sleeveless, crop top, mesh or silk-screened shirts

Nail Polish:

- Remove any nail polish before reporting

Shoes:

- Closed shoe with rubber sole
- No sandals of any kind or backless shoes

One final note: Please be aware of the weather and bring any necessary protection, such as a raincoat in a solid color or sunscreen. Also, portable phones, radios, stereos, headsets, cell phones, and laser pointers are not permitted and should be left at home.
